Reasons and Normativity: Themes from Raz

Call for papers

We invite research postgraduate students at the University of London to submit their work to be presented at this workshop. The submission need not address Raz's work directly, but it should deal with central themes in Raz's work—including, but not limited to, reasons and normativity.

Submissions:

- must not contain any identifying information;
- must be written in English;
- should not exceed 4000 words (including notes but excluding bibliography);
- should be accompanied by abstracts of no more than 500 words long.

Submissions selected for presentation will be circulated to registered participants, including a respondent, about a month in advance of the workshop. During the session, the presenter will be asked to speak for ca. 30 minutes summarising the paper.

We particularly encourage submissions by students from groups who are underrepresented in the discipline.

The closing date for submission is **midday 12:00 on Tuesday 19 April, 2022**. Late submissions will not be considered. Successful applicants will be notified by Friday, 13 May 2022.
